Where: Camp Winnebago near Caledonia, MN. This is the same facility we have used for several years.

This is a beautiful, clean, spacious building with a large community room that has many windows and great lighting.

Meals: We have arranged for Elsie's of Caledonia to cater in meals. We will have 1 meal on Thursday evening, 3 meals on Friday, 3 meals on Saturday and, and 2 meals on Sunday. We enjoyed Elsie's meals last year!

retreat. Cutting mats and ironing stations will be set up, but you will need to bring your own cutting equipment and all your project and sewing supplies.

Directions to Camp Winnebago:

From Waukon: Go north out of Waukon on Hwy 76 to Eitzen, MN. Continue north on Hwy 76 for approximately three miles. Watch for the green street sign that reads Camp Winnebago Road (gravel

road). Turn right onto Camp Winnebago Road and follow for about two miles to the bottom of the hill. The road is narrow and curvy. At the bottom, the camp gate is on the left.

From Decorah: Go north out of Decorah traveling on Locust Road to 4-way stop. Turn east (right) on Big Canoe Road which is also A26. Follow that until you come to Hwy 76. Turn north (left) to Eitzen, MN. Continue north on Hwy 76 for approximately three miles. Watch for the green street sign that reads Camp Winnebago Road (gravel road). Turn right onto Camp Winnebago Road and follow for about two miles to the bottom of the hill. The road is narrow and curvy. At the bottom, the camp gate is on the left.

Pattern and kit or fabrics as needed according to the pattern, Mike has an alternate layout using:

5 fat quarters (3 - backgrounds, 1 - moons, 1 - sashing) plus 1/4 yard for binding

Sewing machine with quarter inch sewing machine foot

(or other open toe foot)

Basic sewing machine supplies (needle, thread, scissors, seam ripper)

Rotary cutting equipment (cutter, large mat and rulers short and long)

 $6" \times 24"$ and $6" \times 12"$ are good sizes

Iron (with and without steam)

Glue-Baste with the long mosquito applicator

Paper cutting scissors

Freezer paper

Blue painter's tape (3/4" or 1")

Marking pen or pencil

Something to draw circles--compass, Olfa circle cutter, or CDs, plates, cups, etc. to trace around circles need to be about 4-5/8", 6-1/2" and 8"
